

# Last Two Weeks of School Schedule

Monday May 8– Wednesday, May 24 Bonita will be dismissing school at 3:00 and all the students will go home on the 3:00 route. **No 4:00 route!**

Tuesday, May 23, the Joe Hundley Field Day events begin at 8:30 and last until 12:00. Several competitive events will be going on during the morning for which parent volunteers will be used.
